- Build ecosystems around the RIPE NCC's data services.

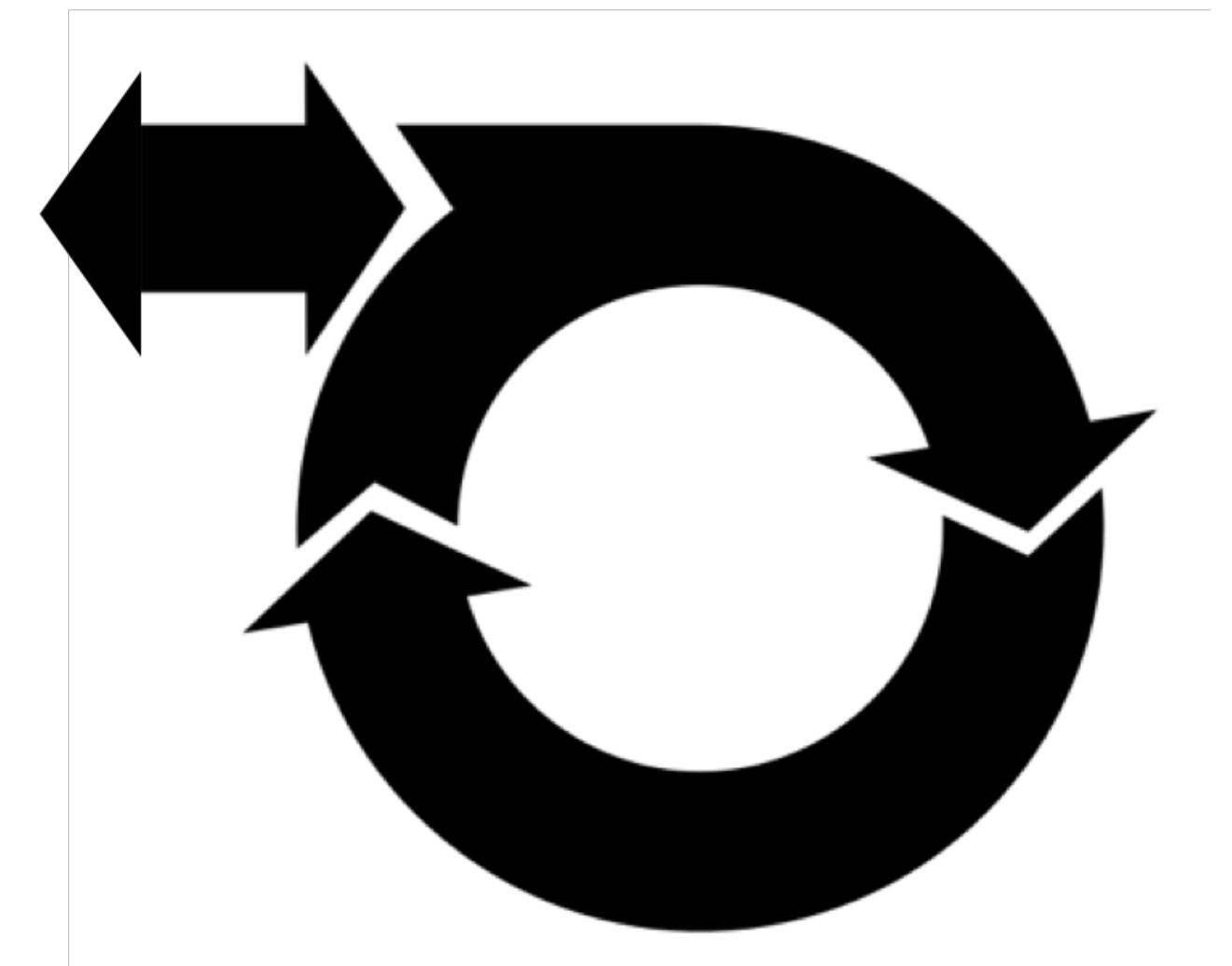
Why Do We Do Community and Development?

Why Do We Do Community and Development?



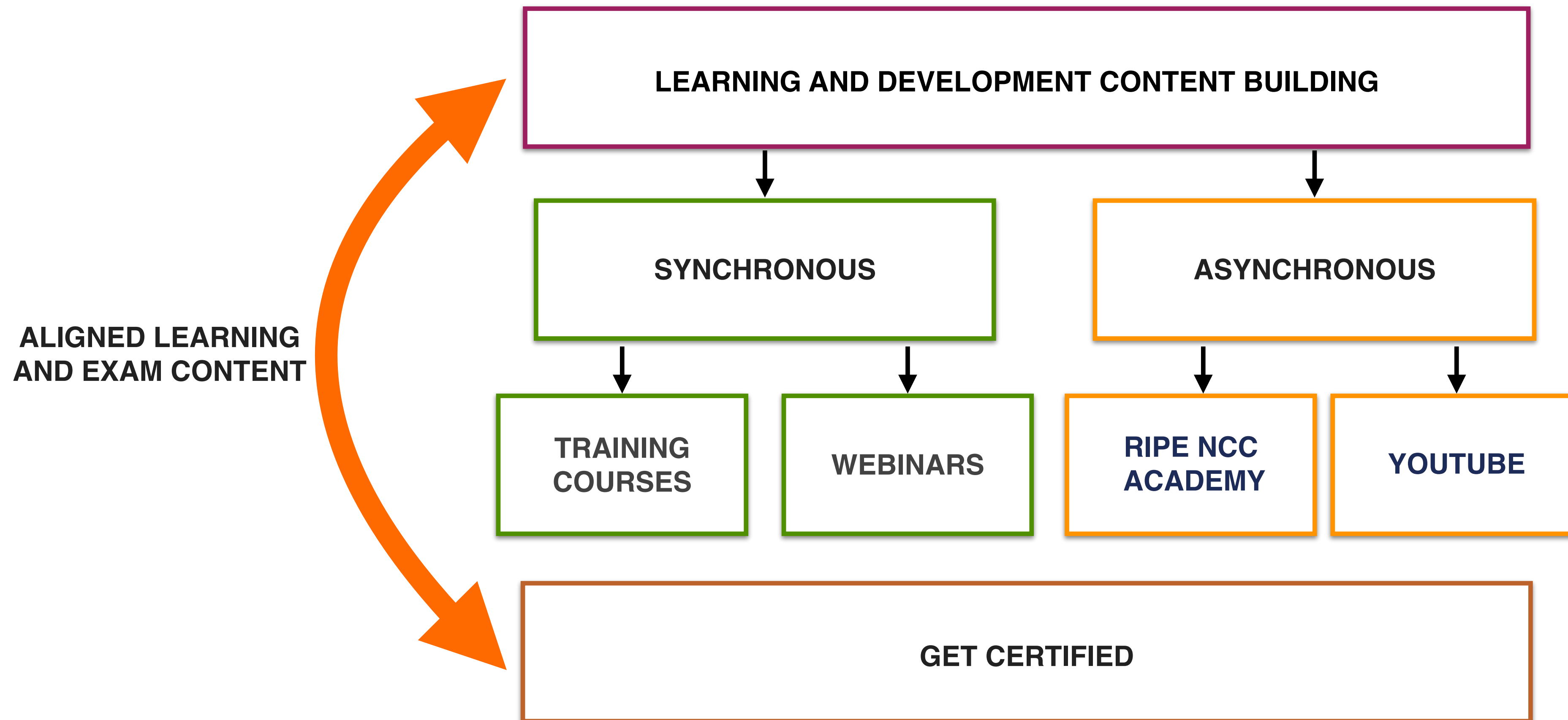
- Community Learning & Development

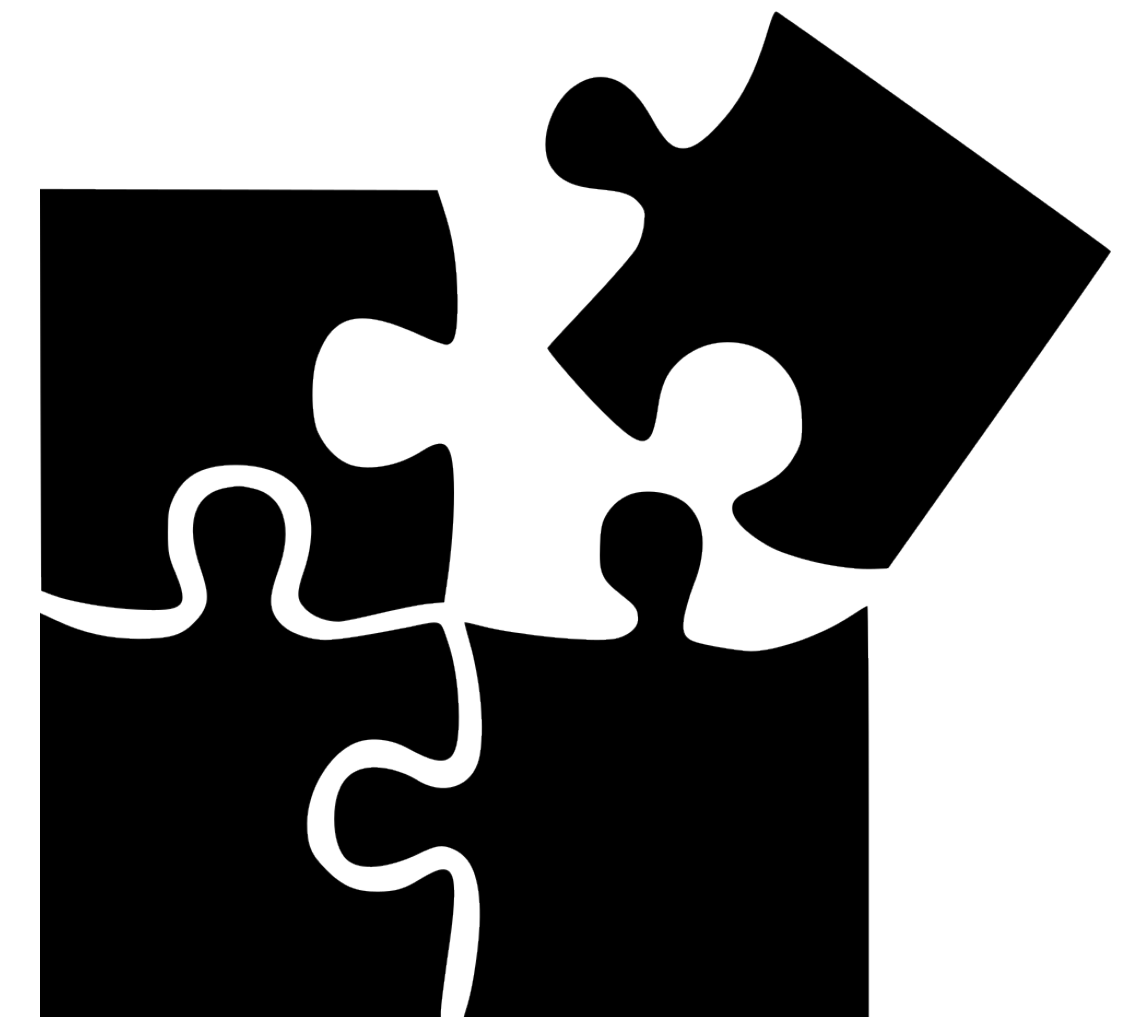

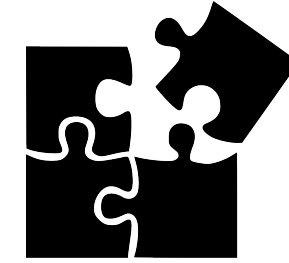
- Community Coordination & Collaboration

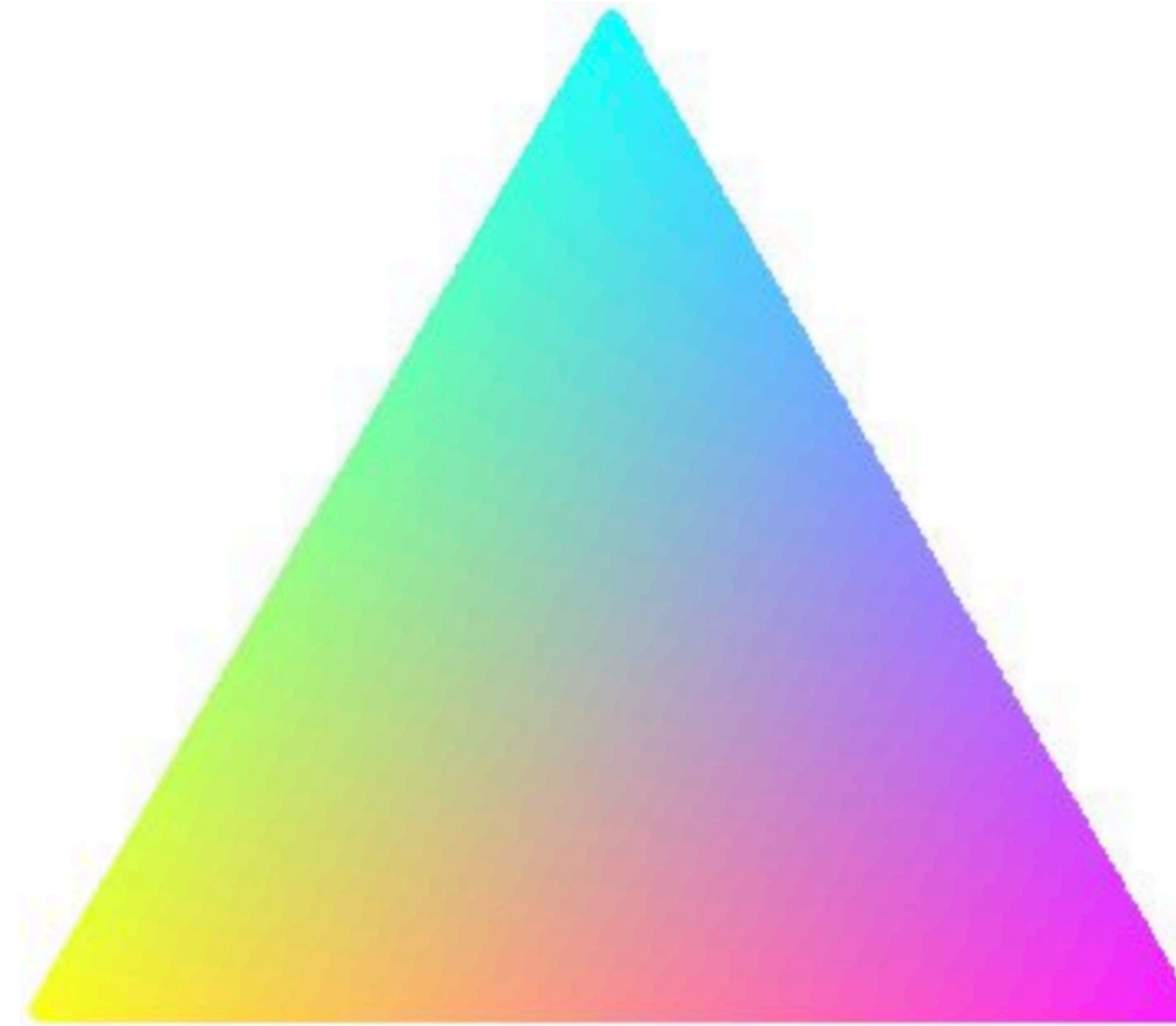

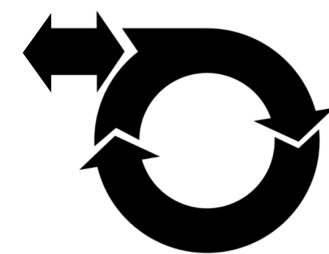
