Traditional Transit



20+ years ago

- ISPs provide Internet transit to organisations (content providers and end-users)
- Enterprise networks changed their Internet access to access and transit providers



What has happened?

- Internet has become an essential part of every organisations services, so they are taking more control over it
- Businesses needed to optimise their services

What are we trying to Address

 Growth in the importance of Internet to business operations is driving enterprise networks to manage their own connection to the internet

 Managing this comes with risk, upskilling staff, learning new best practices, speaking and understanding the peering language

 Now there's more than one connection to manage & monitor i.e. IXPs but you also have a bunch of peers



What are we trying to Address

- Taking control of network growth
 - Having the right resources, IP Addresses, ASNs
 - How do you manage your peers
 - With who and how are you going to peer? Community, what's that?
